Attendees: 30 neighborhood and area residents and businesspeople, Sgt. Roger Legendre of APD Southeast Area, Councilor Pat Davis, Aaron Nieto of Mayor Keller's Office, and Maggie Hart Stebbins, County Commissioner.

- 1. President Julie Kidder called the meeting to order welcomed everyone. Everyone introduced themselves.
- 2. Sgt. Legendre discussed 2016 and 2017 crime statistics for the area, including the significant increase in the number of crimes from 619 incidences in 2016 to 802 incidences in 2017. He also discussed the two-month intensive effort in the Bricklight area in the fall of 2017 that reduced crime by 17 percent. Since that effort was stopped, crime incidences are back at the higher levels. He answered questions on crime, and stated that he has a three-year contact to do community policing. - 3. Councilor Pat Davis distributed his newsletter, discussed recent legislation, including related to crime, and responded to questions about various issues, including Lead and Coal and developing additional data, as UHA has requested.
- 4. Aaron Nieto answered questions related to the mayor's office and stated that he would find responses to various issues that were raised.
- 5. Commissioner Maggie Hart Stebbins discussed some activities with the County Commission and responded to questions.
