

2012 UHA Annual Meeting  
January 29, 2012

Attendees: 19 neighborhood residents and businesspeople, Rep. Gail Chasey, and Councilor Ike Benton.

1. President Lanny Heinlen welcomed everyone. Board members and other attendees introduced themselves.
2. Rep. Gail Chasey discussed re-districting and the current 30-day Legislative session and answered questions about the budget, education, and other issues.
3. Councilor Isaac Benton discussed re-districting and other issues, including transportation. He is still supporting a neighborhood traffic impact study once Lead and Coal are completed. He is supporting a bill to make gas stations a conditional use in the C-1 Neighborhood Commercial zone, in response to problems with the Smith's gas station at Carlisle and Constitution.
4. Neighborhood concerns were: Gilchrist property lot future development and current trash problems; support for community gardens, clean-ups, more streetlighting (including for safety), parking permits (distribution, hours, enforcement) and UNM parking problems.
5. Lanny Heinlen encouraged those concerned about the fencing blocking the sidewalk at some beer and wine locations in the Bricklight District to call in complaints. Marlene Brown encouraged those interested in the Neighborhood Patrol to share ideas with how to proceed.
