Minutes
Monday April 6, 2020
7:00 p.m. on GoToMeeting

I. Preliminary Items

- A. Call to order – President Julie Kidder called the meeting to order at 7:11 pm.
- B. Introductions – Julie Kidder, Marlene Brown, Jennifer Simpson, Sherry Smith, Jasper Rey, and Don Hancock.
- C. Approval of agenda – approved.
- D. Approval of minutes of March 2, 2020 meeting – approved as submitted.
- E. Next meetings – Monday, May 4 at 7; Monday, June 1 at 7, likely to be virtual, but will be noticed when the agenda goes out.
- F. Open forum – Marlene’s birthday is Saturday, so she’d like ideas for what to do since she can’t have a nice party. Sherry’s birthday was March 13, so all her plans got cancelled. Jennifer’s birthday is in August, so perhaps they’ll have a joint party. Jennifer wonders about Richard, as she hasn’t heard, so she’ll call him. Jasper still is interested in putting up slow down Albuquerque type signs; Marlene is volunteering at the City Emergency Operations Center, and she’ll check to see if they have more signs. Marlene fell and broke her nose hiking and went to urgent care. Jasper goes to the bosque with his dog, but there are a lot of people there now.

- D. UNM design for northwest corner of Central and Girard. Marlene, Jasper, Sherry, Julie, and Don responded to the survey, and Jennifer will do it.

- F. Solid waste – Sherry hasn’t heard anything more from Solid Waste. Jasper has been having pickup twice a week, but they missed one week and it created a mess. The driver hasn’t been putting the dumpster in the right location. Marlene suggests that he call 311 about the problem.
- G. Zoning – EPC IDO changes to the City Council includes the UHA Solar Access provision, but not the reduced parking on transit corridors. The Council Land Use Committee will have one or more hearings before the Council takes final action later in the spring.
